END OF TERM III 2016 CIRCULAR

Please, receive our sincere greetings and love from the entire community of Leo Atubo College and thank you for the trust you put in us to take care of your children. I assure you that we have done our best to fit in your shoes and take good care of them. It's now my pleasure to officially inform you that we have today **2nd Dec 2016 at 9:00am** come to the closure of this term III 2016. We therefore thank God Almighty for His care, love and protection that we end the term and year successfully.

ACADEMICS

Gratitude to the teachers for their continued commitment to ensure that teaching and learning goes successfully, they conducted night preps and early morning preps effectively throughout the term, and administered mid term and end of term exams successfully. We could not administer welcome exams due to low turn at the beginning of the term that would render the exams meaningless. The extra lessons were also conducted in all classes. Meanwhile Candidates were engaged in a series of discussions and internal seminars using a number of external mock pass papers we acquired from our partner Schools. All students have therefore been issued end of term report cards which we expect parents to study, analyze and advice accordingly. As policy of the school those students who have been constantly declining have been made to repeat their classes so that they can improve. Meanwhile the S.4 and S.6 candidates also completed their exams successfully. We hope for great improvement in the results

GEOGRAPHY STUDY TOUR

In consultation with the geography teachers, we shall start taking students for the study while in S.3 and S.5 with effect of next year. This is to allow for ample time for revision while in S.4 and reduce on the burden of payments parents go through while their children reach candidate class. However, we inform parents that this tour is not just done for the purpose of visiting new places but these are places very rich with the geographical features that they learn in theory yet also being one of the compulsory questions in UNEB exam so parents need to treat it very seriously and comply.

DISCIPLINE

We continue to register improvement in the discipline of our students most especially the departure of Senior Four candidate. Thanks to the parents who were involved in disciplining their children in the course of the term/year that has brought this improvement. I am happy to note that there has been improvement in the use of English Language as the official medium of communication, smartness and general cleanliness in boys' dormitory. The worst cases of indiscipline were experienced in S.4, a few cases with S.6 girls and as usual minor cases of stubbornness in S.1 and S.2. We have a very big challenge with the current generation that require very close supervision and constant guidance which supervision and guidance should therefore continue without a break. I therefore urge all parents to keep constant look over their children while at home.

NB: Be informed that those who reduce their uniforms shall be made to purchase new ones.

CO-CURRICULAR

There has been a lot of effort put to encourage and strengthen students' participation in games and sports and clubs and societies through adequate facilitation and motivation. This has greatly improved on their morale and willingness. We organized a Community Day on the 27th Nov 2016 in which the students performed a variety of activities i.e. gymnastic show, pattern dance and Volleyball and football match between the school and the community teams in which the school team that composed of students and staff beat the community team in both games. We have now planned to have this as an annual event so as to strengthen our relationship with the community.

SCHOOL FEES

We have had a great improvement on fee payment this term, thanks to those parents who managed to pay all their dues in the course of the term. However, there are a few students who have not cleared their dues that must be paid before the end of the year. The price of food and other items have greatly increased and therefore increasing expenses though our fee structure remains unchanged. We therefore urge parents to pay fees on time. The additional **10,000=** is the annual subscription for clubs and societies paid once every year. Our Bankslips and other documents can be got from Olang House, Maruli Road between National Water and Sewerage Co-operation and White Coaches Garage/Olet Elyak House.

Visitation for next term will be on Sunday 12th March 2017. We continue urging all parents to attend visitation so that they can notice the trend of the child's academic performance and discipline and chart a way forward with the teachers.

HOLIDAY WORK

We plan to accomplish the following work before students report for term one 2017;

1. Construction of the girls incinerator
2. Face-lifting the school in preparation for 10years celebration in 2nd term
3. Plumbing work in the 3 laboratories to have water running in the labs
4. Purchase of DSTV for students and staff entertainment and learning
5. Repair of damaged furniture; beds, lockers and tables
